



Replacing Easyboot Cables

- With a flathead screwdriver, push out the little “sleeve” from under the buckle – this is the piece that holds the cable ends together. (You will want to take the cables out of the notch on the front of the boot and loosen the cable up front for ease of getting that crimped piece out of there.)
- Cut the cable and carefully remove it from the boot, taking note of how the cable is strung around the rivets. It is good to have another Easyboot next to you, so it will be easy to remember how to re-string the cable.
- Take the new cable and string it through the holes in the boot. The two loose ends will fit through the notch on the front of the boot, and then go together down under the buckle.
- With the flathead screwdriver, push the ends of the new cable out from under the buckle far enough to put the sleeve around the ends, and crimp. You can probably start this with a strong grip and some pliers, but we lay the wire with sleeve attached on a solid object and smack it with a hammer!
- Then push that crimped end piece back under the buckle, and you are done!
