

## **Original Easyboot Keeper Strap Installation**

Tools needed: Phillips head screwdriver, and a nail or piece of wire.

## Before you start: Make sure your Easyboot buckle is up and the cable is loose.

- 1. Unfasten the top screw and gold t-nut (the screw set that is closest to the front of the boot) on one side of your Easyboot while holding the washer, white roller, and cable assembly securely in place.
- 2. Insert a penny nail (a paperclip or piece of wire can substitute) into the hole where the screw was in order to keep assembly in place. Set the screw and t-net aside



- 3. Carefully unfasten the remaining screws on the same side and remove.
- Pull the unfastened Backstrap away from the boot, keeping the nail in the assembly.
- 5 Hold your Keeper strap so that the open loop of the shorter piece is at the bottom and the pastern loop is toward the front of the boot. Slip the loop over your Backstrap until it reaches the heel of the boot.
- Replace the Backstap in its original position and carefully re-fasten the top screw and gold T-nut assembly.
- Re-attach the remaining screws and gold T-nuts. You are now ready to put your Easyboots on.
- 8 Once your boots are on, the Keeper strap should be fastened loosely around the pastern. It should be loose enough to get your finger underneath, but not so loose that the strap will slip off the hoof if the boot comes off
